

Coronado Center Exhibit Guidelines

Exhibit at Coronado is open to all Brush Strokes Members

- 1) Only members in good standing may enter
- 2) Artwork must have wired hangers. No saw tooth hangers are permitted. Not all artwork need be framed, if it is Gallery Wrap Canvas (finished on all sides), or Clay Board Mount on Wood. If an entered piece does not comply, the Show Chairperson may reject it. All decisions by the Chairperson will be final on what, and where, paintings are to be hung
- 3) Artwork must be delivered on the specified date, time and place
- 4) Artwork must be picked up on the specified date, time and place
- 5) A card must be placed on the front and back of the painting with the following information:
 - a. Artist name
 - b. Title of painting
 - c. Medium
 - d. Price of painting if it is for sale.
 - e. Phone number of the artist

Members may deliver for hanging, two (2) small paintings or one (1) large. If more paintings are received than there is space, the Chairperson will make the final decision on which will be displayed.

When delivering the artwork, each participant must also complete the form “Wall Display Agreement” required by the Coronado Center.

Brush Strokes is an association of members promoting original fine art.

As such, only original artwork or prints of your original artwork may be submitted. Please, no copy work, or art done in a workshop where participants paint the same subject. Only artwork done from photos, or photos of others by permission, plein-air, still life, or your own original design and composition, should be entered.
